### **Medical Examination II**

Please print out and bring this form to a physician along with the results of all of the following tests: a chest x- ray (for TB), a blood test (for HIV and hepatitis) and urine test (for amphetamines, methamphetamines and opioids).

1. Tuberculosis: Verified by a chest X-Ray film examination
2. Severe Asthma: Examined from medical history
3. Leprosy
4. Epilepsy
5. Severe Forms of the Following Diseases (determined by medical history and physical examination):
  - a. Diabetes
  - b. High blood pressure (anything over 140/90 ml)
  - c. Heart disease (severity requiring constant medication)
6. HIV: Examined from blood test for ANTI-HIV
7. Illicit drugs (amphetamines, methamphetamines and opioids): Examined from urine test
